In recent years, the Greek wine industry has undergone tremendous improvements with serious investments in modern wine making technology.

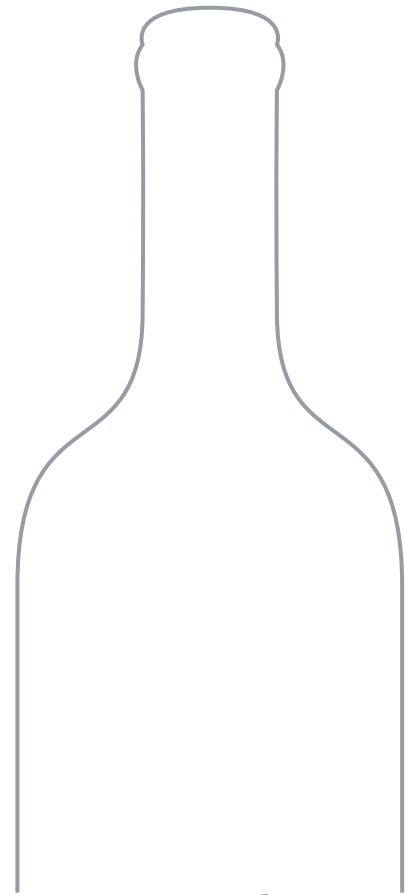

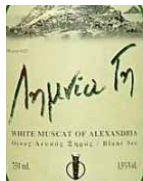
